<p><i>Students entering Grades 1 – 2</i></p>	<p>Have students complete each of the 4 activities one time a week. Click on each subject area and that will lead you to the activities. If an activity does not have a stopping point, a good amount of time to work is 30 minutes.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. <p><i>Students entering grades 3-4</i></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Math - Adaptive Math (any domain you choose) -Suggestion – try a few different domains throughout the summer. 2. Math -Focus Skills 3. ELA – Informational Text or Literature (You may rotate between each every other week.) 4. ELA – Writing/Language (If entering grade 4, you may rotate between a writing activity and a Language activity every other week.)
